ELIGIBILITY & CONDITIONS FOR KAUMATUA FLAT APPLICANTS

Policy	Kaumātua Whare are provided for permanent accommodation for Kaumātua who are in need. In return those Kaumātua are expected to provide a korowai of manaakitanga and tikanga to the lwi of the marae and manuhiri.	
Purpose	The purpose of this Policy is to ensure Whakatū Marae Kōmiti and Kaiwhakahaere establish appropriate and effective processes for the selection of tenant's for Kaumātua Whare.	
Scope	To assist in the selection of Tenants for Kaumātua Whare.	
Responsibilities	This Policy and subsequent procedures are managed by the Marae Kōmiti and Kaiwhakahaere.	
Eligibility	 The following are some of the key eligibility factors that the Kōmiti and Kaiwhakahaere will take into account when deciding who will be allocated a vacant whare: Whakapapa to one of the six lwi of Whakatū Marae; Ko Ngāti Koata, Ngāti Toarangatira, Ngāti Rarua, Ngāti Kuia, Te Ātiawa, Ngāti Tāma Have reached the age of retirement Are role models and are considered Kaumātua by their whanau and lwi; Are able to lead or support hui on the marae; Have whānau support in meeting all their personal needs and comforts as required; Do not currently own their own home. 	
Process	Where a vacancy arises the Marae Kōmiti will notify the six Iwi and the Whakatū Marae community and provide a deadline for nominations. Nominations must be received in writing by the due date and be endorsed by their Iwi or Māori community. Previous applicants will be contacted to confirm whether they wish to be consider for a whare. Written applications are to be completed using the Appendix 1 application form.	
Conditions	 i) Applicants may not necessarily meet all of the guidelines, terms of references or roles. ii) Preference will be given to Kaumatua who are conversant in te reo me ona tikanga and are willing to support the mahi of the Marae. iii) Means testing to ascertain the degree of 'need' may be considered in determining who has a greater need for housing. iv) Whakatū Marae accepts the fact that at some stage, Kaumātua may not be able to contribute to the 'life' of the marae due to age condition or physical ability. v) To ensure safety and wellbeing of all living and working on the Marae successful applicants must agree to undergo a police vetting process. (Vulnerable Child's Act 2014) vi) Applications must be endorsed by their iwi. 	
Special Note	vii) Whānau will follow Whakatū Marae Kōmiti accepted procedures surrounding the Kaumātua Whare when visiting. viii) Residents must maintain their whare and surrounds according to the tenancy agreement.
