

Energie Fruit Environment for Life Scholarship

The following information outlines the conditions and process for potential Scholarship applicants. Please read through the guidelines carefully before you start your application.

The Scholarship was established in 2010 by the Energie Fruit Charitable Trust

- 1. The Scholarship will be known as the Energie Fruit Environment for Life Scholarship.
- 2. The Scholarship will consist of a one off payment of \$2,000.00 towards tertiary fees for one year. One scholarship will be made available annually.
- 3. Applicants for the Scholarship must be New Zealand citizens or New Zealand permanent residents.
- 4. The Scholarship is open to local applicants who are leaving secondary education and are enrolling for their first year of full-time tertiary education at a recognised tertiary education provider.
- 5. Under the Scholarship the term **local** is defined as being within the Tasman District Zone as far south as Murchison.
- 6. The applicant will be enrolled in studies toward a degree that fall into either of the Environmental, Agricultural or Horticultural fields.
- 7. In selecting the successful applicant for the Energie for Life Scholarship the Selection Panel will give preference to applicants:
 - a) Of high academic calibre and who have achieved at a high level in their secondary school examinations
 - b) Who show qualities of integrity, competence, leadership, enthusiasm and self-motivation.
 - c) Who demonstrate a strong commitment to the field of horticulture, agriculture and/or the environment.
- 8. The Scholarship Selection Panel will consider students that already hold other scholarships or similar awards that are assisting their tertiary education.
- 9. In application all applicants must complete/forward:
 - a) an application form
 - b) a current CV

c) a personal statement of between 600 and 800 words detailing why they wish to take up a career in either the horticultural, agricultural or environmental fields.

- d) a certified copy of current academic record or NCEA Record of Achievement
- e) two academic references (see clause 10 for details)
- f) proof of acceptance into a New Zealand Tertiary Educational Organisation
- 10. Applicants must obtain two academic references which are to be sent directly to the Scholarship postal address. An academic reference form (PDF) can be downloaded by following the link provided. Applicants are responsible for ensuring their references send the completed reference forms to the address provided by the closing date for applications.

- 11. The annual cut off date for Environment for Life Scholarship applications is the 1st of September. Applications received after this date will not be considered.

- 13. The Scholarship Selection Panel will comprise of members of the Energie Fruit Company Board.
- 14. Applicants may be required to attend an interview with the Scholarship Selection Panel.
- 15. The Scholarship Selection Panel may recommend that the scholarship be re-advertised if there are insufficient applications of merit.
- 16. At the discretion of the Selection Panel the scholarship funding may be shared.
- 17. All decisions of the Selection Panel are final and no correspondence shall be entered into.
- 18. The Scholarship funds will be credited directly to the fees account of the successful applicant.
- 19. A Scholarship may be terminated if the Scholarship Selection Panel deems that the programme of study is no longer being undertaken or followed by the recipient. The recipient shall have the right to appeal any such termination.
- 20. The Scholarship Selection Panel reserves the right to require repayment of the Scholarship in whole or in part in the event of the recipient(s) withdrawal from the course of study. Any repayment will be decided on a case by case basis having taking into consideration the circumstances surrounding the withdrawal.
- 21. The recipient of a Scholarship agrees to participate in publicity concerning the Scholarship.
- 22. The information forwarded as part of a Scholarship application will be used solely for the purposes of assessing your application by the Scholarship Selection Panel. Referees may be contacted as part of the assessment process.
- 23. The Energie Fruit Charitable Trust may at any time vary these regulations if deemed necessary.


